


# Compatibility Report

## Guna Milan

Kundali Milan, also known as Gun Milan, assesses compatibility between a prospective husband and wife based on their Rashi (zodiac sign) and Nakshatras (birth stars). It provides insight into their potential nature, love, understanding, and other aspects. Gun Milan uses the Ashtakoota system, which evaluates eight different aspects of life after marriage. These eight aspects, known as Kootas, are assigned points ranging from 1 for Varna Koota to 8 for Nadi Koota. Together, these points total 36, famously known in Northern parts of India as Chhattis Gun.

The table below details the compatibility between the boy and the girl in various areas of life, according to the Ashtakoota system.

## Guna Milan Interpretation

In Gun-Milan system of match making, Nadi Kuta is given supreme priority during match making. If Nadi Kuta is unfavourable then a match with 28 Gunas is also considered inauspicious.

In Gun-Milan, the maximum number of Gunas are 36. when Bhakuta Kuta and Nadi Kuta is favourable, If total Gunas between the couple are between 31 and 36 then the union is excellent, Gunas between 21 and 30 are very good, Gunas between 17 and 20 (both inclusive) are Average and Gunas between 0 and 16 are inauspicious.

If Bhakuta Kuta is unfavourable then union is never excellent, Gunas between 26 and 29 are very good, Gunas between 21 and 25 are Average and Gunas between 0 and 20 are inauspicious.

The interpretations below denotes the Gun Milaan points obtained by the Bride and the Groom in detail.

### Varna Koot

The Varna indicates the level of spiritual or ego development in the couples getting married. Based on the janma-rashi, Varna is divided into four categories such as the Brahmin, Kshatriya, Vaisya, and Sudra. Marriage is considered to be ideal if the grade or caste of the groom is higher than the bride.

The boy and the girl both belong to Vaishya Varna. This type of combination is very much favorable for a union. For this couple Varna Koot is Good.

### Vasya Koot

Vasya assess the degree of magnetic control or influence the husband or wife can exert on each other. Each Moon sign has specific signs that are amenable to their control, these are classified into five categories and they are Chatuspada, Manava, Jalachara, Vanachara, and Keeta. For a compatible marriage life, it is ideal for two people with moon signs of the same group to get married.

The boy and the girl both belong to Chatuspada Vasya. This is an excellent match. For this couple Vasya Koot is Excellent.

## Tara Koot

Tarakoot is evaluated by counting the number of stars between the groom's birth star and the bride's birth star. A marriage is considered ideal when the birthstar, or janmatara, of both partners align favorably.

The boy and the girl both belong to the same Tara Group. The boy's nakshatra Rohini is 1st position from girl's nakshatra Rohini and this is Benefic. At the same time the girl's nakshatra Rohini is 1st position from boy's nakshatra Rohini and this is Benefic. This is so far the best compatible match. For this couple Tara Koot is Excellent.

## Yoni Koot

Yoni measures the sexual compatibility between the couples. Considering the constellations, there are both male and female constellations, and each of the nakshatra is related to an animal. For a happy married life, union between the people of the same class of yoni or animal is considered auspicious.

The boy and the girl both belong to the same Yoni Sarpa. This is a warm and gratifying combination. For this couple Yoni Koot is Excellent.

## Graha Maitri

Graha Maitri is based on the goodwill between the ruling planets and their respective moon rasis, and it examines the psychological disposition of the couples. The graha maitri is calculated based on the relationship between the lunar rulers of the groom and the bride. If the lunar rulers share friendship the marriage is considered to be ideal.

The boy and the girl both belong to same Rasi Lord Venus. The boy and the girl both come under the same Rasi Vrishabha. This is one of the best compatible match. For this couple Graha Maitri Koot is Excellent.

## Gana Koot

There are three ganas or temperaments and the gana kuta measures the compatibility of temperament essential for a happy marriage life. Each nakshatras is assigned with one of the three ganas, which are Deva, Manushya, and Rakshasa. For a compatible married life, it is ideal for two people within the same gana to get married.

The boy and the girl both belong to same Gana Manushya. This is considered to be an excellent combination for gana match. For this couple Gana Koot is Excellent.

## Bhakoot Koot

Bhakoot emphasizes the Moon signs (rasis) of the couple and signifies the overall happiness of the married life. It is considered auspicious when woman's moon sign follows man's moon. Further if the moons are at the same sign, nakshatras are considered, and it is considered beneficial if the woman's Moon nakshatra follows the man's.

Zodiac sign for the boy and the girl is Vrishabha. This is an excellent combination from the happiness and prosperity point of view. For this couple Bhakoot Koot is Excellent.

## Nadi Koot

The Nadi Kuta relates to progeny. It reflects the nervous system's Ayurvedic constitution, influenced by the Moon and other planets. The three nadis are vata, pitta, and kapha. Ideally, a couple's Moon and nakshatras should fall in different nadis for compatibility.

The boy and the girl both belong to same Nadi Antya. This is inauspicious combination. For this couple Nadi Koot is not Good.
